










PROJECT LIFECYCLE




FP7 Participation: Project Life Cycle








5 Contract Negotiation: The tasks

All parties have to accede to the Grant agreement

It is the CONTRACTUALLY BINDING DOCUMENT !! The Consortium must deliver what is agreed in that ...



5 Roll Out and Implementation The Consortium Agreement 3/4

- It regulates the relations among the beneficiaries
- It is a condition imposed by the Commission in the Grant agreement
- It must be signed in parallel by all the beneficiaries
