





EC-NCP Cooperation



European Commission:

- Publish NCPs on CORDIS & other legal documents
- Provide training for NCPs
- Organise events and support (finance) NCP participation
- Provide info on WPs, calls, roadmaps, procedures, funded projects, expression of interests
- Provide promotion materials (booklets, leaflets)
- NCP extranet (CORDIS NCP Forums)
- Finance NCP projects
- Co-organise regional/national events
- NCP correspondants

Representation in Programme Committee



Keep in mind: You are representing your Country's priorities!

- ✓ You provide input for shaping Work Programme
- ✓ You provide input for budgets earmarked for specific topics.
- ✓ You negotiate for your country's proposals
- ✓ You have access to some very critical databases

You have direct effect on your success!



Representation in Programme Committee



An ideal Program Committee Memeber should:

- ✓ Have knowledge about FP7 dynamics
- ✓ Have knowledge on national R&D and Industrial Landscape
- ✓ Have moderate scientific knowledge on the thematic priority he/she is representing
- ✓ Have good connections with related national institutions



Representation in Programme Committee



Regularly attend Programme Committee meetings

- ✓ To keep track of new instruments, don't miss oppotunities (eg. PPPs, FET Flagship)
- ✓ Inform your national authority about possible actions
- ✓ Meet other countries, see their competencies and priorities

- Positive for your image and reputation






The Bad News







Promote Visibility

- Always have your organizations profiles with you
 - To send European counterparts
 - To immediately respond partner searches
 - Access to national databases

So, collect organizations' profiles



Promote Visibility

- Disseminate your profiles in big FP7 events
- Open your country stand in suitable events
- Let them know that that Moldova is <u>fully eligible</u> for their proposals!







Promote Visibility

- Organize bilateral workshops with big players
 - ST Ericsson, SAP, Fraunhofer, INTEL, ENEA
- Make in depth analysis of the strong R&D networks and direct your clients to these networks
